

Utilizing Vehicle intelligence

Recently the European Union passed a legislation called Euro 5, which among other things requires the vehicle manufacturers to provide the possibility for independent workshops to download new software to a vehicle in a standardized way, using a generic pass thru interface.

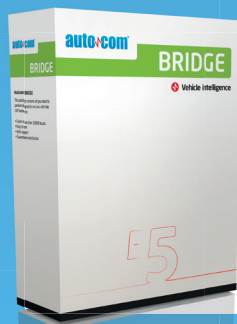
The main purpose of Euro 5 is to reduce emissions from passenger cars. The legislation came into force autumn 2009. The vehicle manufacturers had a period until September 1st 2010 to comply with all parts of the legislation. Euro 5 has and will continue to have an affect on everything from vehicle development to vehicle diagnostics. As a response to that, Autocom now releases SoftBridge, a state of the art and economical solution for the modern workshop.

SoftBridge is a tool that allows you to download new software to all of the Euro 5 type approved vehicles reprogrammable electronic control units. You simply connect the SoftBridge between a vehicle and a PC connected to the Internet, and then you can buy and download new pieces of software directly from the vehicle manufacturers Internet portals.

To make things even easier Autocom is now setting up a new website called the SoftBridge-portal that will launch every time you connect your SoftBridge to the computer. On the SoftBridge-portal you will among other things be able to get help, training, support and find direct links to all vehicle manufacturers Internet portals.
